

SOLANO COUNTY DROUGHT RESTRICTIONS

For more information regarding water restrictions in your area please call your cities water service; phone numbers are provided below.

STATE PROHIBITIONS:

- Landscape irrigation that runs off of your property
- Irrigating landscaping during or 48 hours following a measureable rain event (greater than 0.25 inches)
- Use of potable water to irrigate street median ornamental turf (non-potable water is OK)
- New landscaping will require high-efficiency irrigation systems as allowed by building code and future WELO requirements
- Washing down sidewalks, driveways or other hardscapes (unless needed for health and safety reasons)
- Decorative fountains that do not recirculate the water
- Serving water at restaurants if not requested by the patron(s)
- Hotels and motels must provide the option to not have towels and linens laundered daily
- Vehicle washing with running water (need to use bucket or automatic shut-off nozzle)

**THE STATE PROHIBITIONS APPLY TO ALL CITIES REGARDLESS OF
ADDITIONAL CITY ORDINANCES**

CITY OF BENICIA

WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

The Benicia City Council is continuing emergency outdoor watering restrictions that limit watering by automatic sprinkler system for both commercial and residential customers.

From April 1 to October 15, outside watering is limited according to the following schedule:

- Even Numbered Addresses (ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8) are permitted to irrigate on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays
- Odd Numbered Addresses (ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9) are permitted to irrigate on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays

From October 16 to March 31, sprinklers will be limited to one day per week – Saturdays or Sundays only (customer choice)

CITY OF DIXON

WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

On June 9th, Dixon City Council considered and adopted an urgency ordinance (with a 4-1 vote) proposed to comply with the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCB) most recent regulations for small water suppliers by limiting outdoor watering to no more than two (2) days per week.

All outside irrigation is prohibited between the hours of 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM

- Even Numbered Addresses (ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8) are permitted to irrigate only on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays
- Odd Numbered Addresses (ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9) are permitted to irrigate only on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays

CITY OF FAIRFIELD

WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

All outside irrigation is prohibited between the hours of 12:00 PM – 6:00 PM

CITY OF RIO VISTA

WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

Section 17.68 of the Rio Vista Municipal Code related to water conservation and landscaping to comply with the California State Water Resources Control Board's adopted mandatory water conservation regulations.

All outdoor irrigation is prohibited between the hours of 9:00A.M -7:00 PM

- Even-Numbered Addresses (ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8) are permitted to irrigate only on Saturdays and Tuesdays
- Odd-Numbered Addresses (ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9) using are permitted to irrigate only on Sundays & Wednesdays

CITY OF SUISUN CITY

WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

- Even Numbered Addresses (ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8) are permitted to irrigate on Mondays and Thursdays
- Odd Numbered Addresses (ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9) are permitted to irrigate on Tuesdays and Fridays

As permitted by the emergency regulation, the District has established the following schedule for violations of prohibited actions;

1. First Offense: Written Notification and Corrective Action provided to Water User.
2. Second Offense: Written Notification and \$50 fine per violation.
 - a. Option; in lieu of a fine, attend a water conservation class sponsored by SSWA. If an offense occurs after attending the class, there will be no eligibility for this option and a fine of \$50 per violation will be levied.
3. Third Offense: Written Notification and \$250 fine per violation.
4. Fourth and subsequent Offenses: Written Notification and \$500 fine per violation, and the Curtailment of Potable Water Service until Corrective Action is guaranteed.

The restrictions apply to both residential and commercial customers and will remain in effect until the Benicia City Council declares an end to water shortage emergency.

Implementation of Fines for Violation of Water Use Prohibition

- The City has an established fine structure for violation of the Water Use Prohibitions listed at the top of the page, with a maximum penalty of \$500 per violation, which currently are not being enforced or implemented. The City's proposal will call for the enforcement of these fines effective July 1, 2015.

CITY OF VALLEJO

WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT

All outdoor irrigation of ornamental landscapes or turf with potable water is prohibited between the hours of 9:00 A.M- 6:00 P.M

- Even-Numbered Addresses (ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8) are permitted to irrigate only on Mondays, Wednesday, and Fridays
- Odd-Numbered Addresses (ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9) using are permitted to irrigate only on Tuesday, Thursdays, and Saturdays

(Except for drip irrigation, soaker hoses and hand watering)

Enforcement penalties ranging from warning notices for 1st time violations, and monetary penalties starting at \$200 for 2nd violations, increasing to \$500 for 3rd time violations.
