Water Saving Technology	Rebates are available for the following items: Rain barrels, pool covers, rain sensors, laundry-to-landscape system components, hot water recirculating system components. Maximum rebate is up to \$50 per product category. All items must be purchased as new. *
Weather Based rrigation Controller	Rebates are available for <u>eligible <b>Water Sense labelled</b></u> irrigation controllers for residential and commercial customers. *Maximum rebate for residential customers is 50% of purchase price up to \$300, commercial customers 50% purchase price up to \$1,000.
Drought Tolerant Tree Rebate	Rebate issued for only native and climate resilient trees. List of eligible trees found on our <u>website</u> . Limit two trees maximum, up to \$50/tree. *
High Efficiency Clothes Washer Rebate	\$100 rebate on eligible Energy Star Most Efficient awarded clothes washing machines. Machine must be purchased new and must be awarded the MOST EFFICIENT label to qualify for the rebate. *

## SOLANO COUNTY WATER CONSERVATION REBATE PROGRAM

### **How to Apply**



Submit the signed application along with supporting documents to Solano County Water Agency. Application and supporting documents may be emailed to: solanocash4grass@scwa2.com or mailed to:

Once applications are received, staff will review them for eligibility. Customers will be notified about the status of their application within five to ten business days. If the application is approved, a check will be mailed to the address on the application within six to eight weeks.

#### SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

#### **Proof of Purchase**

Please provide a copy of the invoice(s) for each rebate selected. Invoices must be recent and submitted within 180 days of the purchase date.





#### **Copy of Most Recent Water Bill**

Provide a copy of your most recent water bill. The bill must show that you are receiving water from a Solano County City. California Water service customers are not eligible for rebates from Solano County Water Agency. If you are a resident of an HOA or do not pay a water bill as part of a rental agreement, you may provide a copy of your energy bill as a substitution.

#### **TERMS OF SERVICE**

- The offer applies to Solano County Water Agency customers who have property or rent property within the service area of Solano County. Dixon customers of California Water Service (Cal Water) are not eligible for a rebate.
- Only qualifying products purchased on/after July 1, 2025, are eligible for a rebate. No exceptions.
- Products must be purchased new. Items won as part of a prize, purchased secondhand or DIY products are not eligible for rebate.
- Limited time offer: Rebates are offered on a first-come, first-served basis and are subject to availability of funds. This program shall always be subject to change or termination without prior notice.
- Rebates do not include the cost of tax, delivery, and labor.
- Rebates are limited per one (1) rebate per product category per household (water account) for the life of the program (with the exception of washing machines); substitutions not allowed. '
- Must include copies of: Purchase receipt within 180 days (six months) of purchase, most recent water bill (for verification of residency in Solano County). Renters and residents of HOA's must include a copy of their electric bill as another form of proof in the case that water bill is paid by HOA or management company.
- SCWA is not responsible for faulty equipment or installation of products, and does not represent the customer, retailer, or manufacturer of reimbursed materials in any dispute.
- Program rebates totaling \$600 or more per calendar year may be considered taxable income. If issued, applicant must submit a W-9 form to SBMWD in order to receive reimbursement. Consult a tax professional for your specific filing requirements.
- Please review the terms of service of each particular rebate category as this list is not an exhaustive list.
