### STEPS TO PARTICIPATE

1. Read the Terms and Conditions.
2. Complete this form and email, fax, or mail it to SCWA. Our email is **[solanocash4grass@scwa2.com](mailto:solanocash4grass@scwa2.com)**. If you have questions concerning this form, please call 707-455-1113.
3. Applications will be processed as they are received until all funds are reserved.
4. Upon receipt of Application, SCWA team will contact the applicant to schedule an inspection visit. Please allow staff five to ten business days to process applications and requests.
5. Following submission of this form or digital application, do not remove lawn until you receive a formal notice of approval document. To be eligible for a rebate, the Lawn Conversion Project must not be started before receipt of an Notice of Approval. Due to high demand, you may be approved and placed on a wait list pending funding availability.
6. Remove the lawn area and install your project according to the program Landscaping Guidelines outlined in the terms and conditions.
7. Complete a digital post-inspection on our website or schedule a post-inspection visit when project is complete. Projects that are not-completed may be disqualified after 120 deadline. Extensions are available upon request.

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## BEFORE YOU APPLY, PLEASE REVIEW CAREFULLY

### Before you apply, your yard must meet the following criterium:

- ✓ Site must be within the Solano County service area. Customers of California Water Service are not eligible for this rebate. If you are a renter, you must submit written verification from your landlord that you have permission to conduct such a project.
- ✓ Your yard must be well-maintained and watered with, at minimum, 50% green coverage. Weeds, wild or invasive grasses, dead or yellowed grass, and bare dirt do not qualify as eligible areas.
- ✓ The water account associated with the site address must be active for a minimum of 12 months.
- ✓ Have not received a rebate in the past with the address/water account associated with the application.
- ✓ Your project site must be at minimum 300 square feet to be eligible.

### All projects must be converted to low-water use landscaping compliant with the terms and coditions of the program and must contain:

- ✓ Ground cover must cover entire area (no bare surface/dirt). Acceptable goundcovers include: mulch (at least 3 inches), pavers, rock, or other organic materialthat sufficienctly covers entire area of yard.
- ✓ A minimum of three (3) plants per every one hundred square feet. Plants must be planted in the ground, not in pots.Only vegetation classified as Very Low, Low, or Moderate water-use in WUCOLS(see Terms and Conditions).
- ✓ Sprinklers capped, removed, or converted to drip irrigation.
- ✓ Biodegradable weed barrier (no plastic sheeting).

### Converted areas **cannot** contain:

- ✗ Existing lawn or invasive plants (plants that are non-native and cancause harm to the ecosystem or economy if realeased to the wild).
- ✗ Artificial turf (fake grass).
- ✗ Rubber Mulch.
- ✗ Traditional sprinklers, run off, leaks or malfunctions.
- ✗ Impermeable surfaces (i.e. concrete, asphalt, plastic, etc.).
