Tour of Old Davis Rd and 106a Putah Creek Crossings on May 12, 2023**

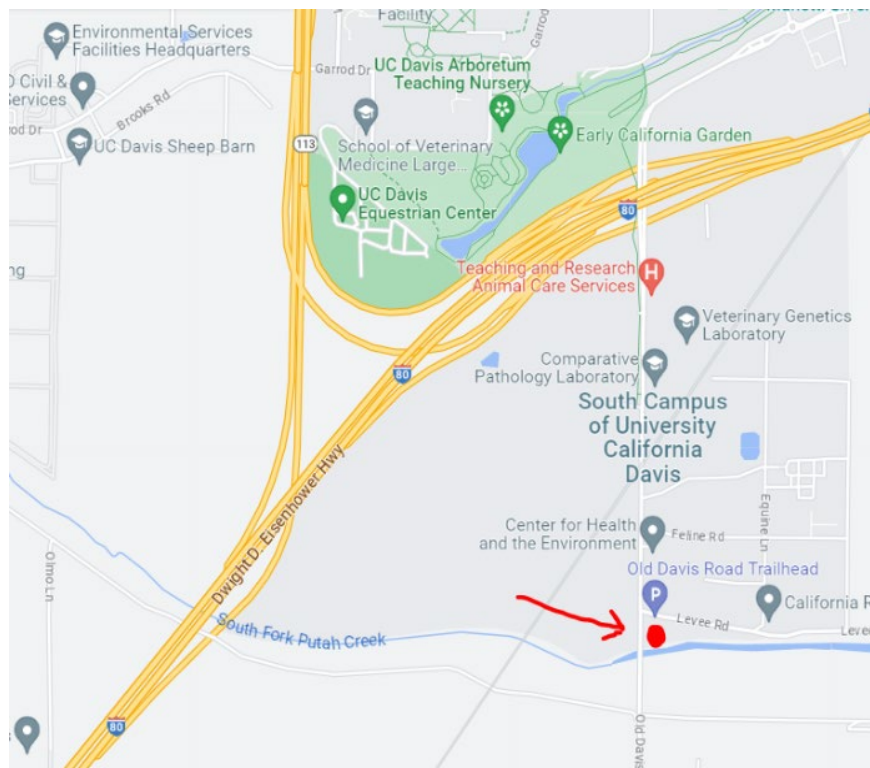
This special meeting of the LPCCC is a field tour beginning at Old Davis Rd (wetland restoration site) and carpooling to County Road 106a on Putah Creek. There will be no actions taken at this meeting, the tour is for informational purposes only.

**Date and Time:** Friday, May 12, 2023 at 9:30 am – 12 pm

**Place:** meet at the gravel parking at the "Old Davis Road Trailhead" on Putah Creek, south of the UC Davis campus.

From Vacaville/SF Bay Area: Take I-80 east toward Sacramento. Exit at "UC Davis", turn right and head south on Old Davis Rd. Cross the railroad tracks. Before the bridge over Putah Creek, turn left and park in the fenced gravel parking area.

From Sacramento: Take I-80 west toward Davis. Take the "UC Davis" exit and turn left (south) on Old Davis Rd. Go under the freeway and cross the railroad tracks. Before the bridge over Putah Creek, turn left and park the fenced gravel parking area.
