DETAILED SUMMARY OF THE MATTER THAT PLAINTIFF SEEKS TO VALIDATE:

The United States Bureau of Reclamation ("United States") constructed the Solano Project ("Solano Project" or "Project") for flood control and for the storage, diversion, carriage, distribution, and beneficial use of water of Putah Creek for the purpose of agricultural, municipal, industrial, and domestic consumption, and other purposes. The United States provides for the delivery of water from the Solano Project to the Agency pursuant to Contract No. 14-06-200-4090R (Contract Between the United States and Solano County Water Agency Providing for Water Service hereinafter "Master Contract"). Article 2 of the Master Contract provides that it shall be renewed upon request by the Agency, pursuant to the Acts of July 2, 1956 (70 Stat. 483), and June 21, 1963 (77 Stat. 68).

The Agency timely initiated the renewal process, and negotiated a final form of renewal of the Master Contract with the United States, in the form of the Renewal Agreement. The Renewal Agreement involves no increase in existing water service or contractual water allocations; no new construction, expansion, or any modification to the existing distribution system of the Agency or the Solano Project; nor any change in the source of water to be delivered, the area of its use, the ownership of the water rights, or the uses to which such supplies will be put.

On February 8, 2024, at a duly noticed and regular meeting of the Agency's Board of Directors, the Board of Directors adopted authorized the execution and delivery of the Renewal Agreement as set forth in Resolution No. 2024-02 (the "Resolution"). Prior to this meeting and in accord with the provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act, Government Code section 54950 et seq., the Agency timely posted and distributed a written agenda for this meeting describing the Board of Directors' intent to consider the adoption of the Resolution, and providing interested parties with the opportunity to review and comment upon the Resolution and Renewal Agreement.

Through the Board's adoption of the Resolution, the Board authorized the approval, execution, and delivery of the Renewal Agreement and authorized additional actions in furtherance thereof. On February 8, 2024, the Agency executed the Renewal Agreement. The
