



Water Conserving Products Terms and Conditions

July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027

The Solano County Water Agency (SCWA) is offering rebates for select water conserving devices. Per category, eligible devices can receive up to a \$50 rebate.

I. Eligibility

- a. **Who Can Apply:** The Program is available to residential customers who receive water from a participating SCWA Member Agencies. These include the cities of Vacaville, Vallejo, Benicia, Suisun City, Fairfield, Rio Vista, and Dixon (not including California Water Service Customers). The water account must have been active for at least twelve months.
- b. **Property:** must belong to the water account holder or must have written permission from the homeowner. Property must be within in Solano County limits.
- c. **Residential Properties Only:** Commercial, institutional, and industrial entities do not qualify for this rebate.

II. Timelines:

- a. **Purchase Window:** Program applies to qualifying products purchased from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, are eligible for a rebate. Products purchased prior to July 1, 2026, may qualify for this rebate program – contact Solano County Water Agency at solanocash4grass@scwa2.com or 707-455-1113 to verify.
- b. **Funding Availability:** Rebates are available for the purchase of qualified products until June 30, 2027, or until funds are depleted, whichever comes first. This program shall always be subject to change or termination without prior notice.
- a. **Purchase Date:** All rebate applications must be postmarked no later than 180 days (six months) after the purchase date. This program shall always be subject to change or termination without prior notice.
- c. **On-Site Installation:** The qualifying products must remain at the installation site for a minimum of twelve (12) months after installation date.

III. Eligible Water-Conserving Products

Products must be purchased new. Items won as part of a prize, purchased secondhand or DIY products are not eligible for rebate.

The following water-conserving products are eligible for a rebate:

ELIGIBLE PRODUCT CATEGORIES

1. Pool Covers:

Rebates are for new covers specifically made for pools. Rebates do not apply to secondhand covers, mesh covers, chemical/liquid covers, or spa covers.

2. Hot Water Recirculating System Components:

Eligible components include electric pumps and thermal bypass valves that create one continuous water supply loop to recirculate water throughout the home.

3. Laundry-to-Landscape (Gray Water) System Components:

Eligible components include a 3-way diverter valve to direct the flow of graywater to the landscape or to the sewer, and/or an air vent to prevent accidental siphoning of water from the clothes washer. Product must be installed as part of a residential clothes washer and meets all requirements for graywater systems as described in the California Plumbing Code. Other system components, including tubing, plumbing parts, outlets, mulch shields, and components installed as part of more complex graywater systems, do not qualify.

4. Rain Barrel:

Only finished containers sold exclusively for rainwater collection are eligible. Secondhand or self-made rain barrels do not qualify. Barrels must have fixed screens, and safety covers that prevent entry of children, mosquitoes, and animals.

5. Rain Sensors:

To qualify for the rebate, the rain sensor must be set to shut-off the irrigation system when it detects 1/8-inch or more precipitation.



IV. Rebate Offer

- a. **Rebate Limitations:** Rebate will not include taxes, labor, installation, shipping/delivery costs, or any discounts applied to the purchase price.
- b. **Rebate Amount:** Rebates cover the cost of qualifying products, up to \$50 per product category excluding tax, delivery, and labor.
- c. **Purchase Limit:** Rebate Limitations: one (1) rebate per product category per household (water account) up to a maximum of five (5) rebates total for the life of the program; substitutions not allowed.
- d. **Rebate Issuance:** A rebate will be issued to address and name on application. Checks typically arrive within six to eight weeks. Please allow for extra processing time during holidays or due to high demand.

V. How to Apply:

You will be required to provide:

- a. **Proof of Purchase:** You must provide a copy of receipt or other proof of purchase for the product. Receipt/proof of purchase must list purchase price, manufacturer, model number, and purchase date.

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- b. **Proof of Installation/Delivery:** Your invoice must provide proof of delivery or installation within a city that receives municipal water (Vacaville, Vallejo, Benicia, Suisun City, Fairfield, Rio Vista, and Dixon).
- c. **Solano County Area Water Bill:** Proof of the most recent water bill is required to confirm that your home receives water from a city in Solano County (Vacaville, Vallejo, Benicia, Suisun City, Fairfield, Rio Vista, and Dixon). If you live in an HOA or similar community entity and pay your water bill to the HOA or similar entity, the substitution of an energy bill may be accepted.
- d. **Meet Terms and Conditions:** Customers must fulfill all program guidelines to be eligible for incentives.

VI. Rebate Agreement & Release of Liability

Rebates are one-time-only per site, and will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Rebates offered are subject to availability of funds. This rebate program may end at any time. SCWA reserves the right to deny any application that does not meet all requirements outlined above. Due to variables beyond the control of SCWA, the Agency cannot guarantee the installation of any product will result in a lower utility bill. The applicant waives and releases SCWA, participating water utilities, and their contractors or agents from any and all claims and causes of action arising out of the installation and use of this product. SCWA is not responsible for any damage that may occur to participants' property as a result of the program.
